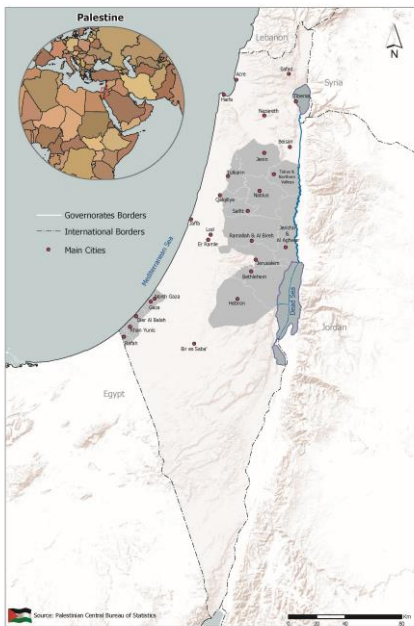

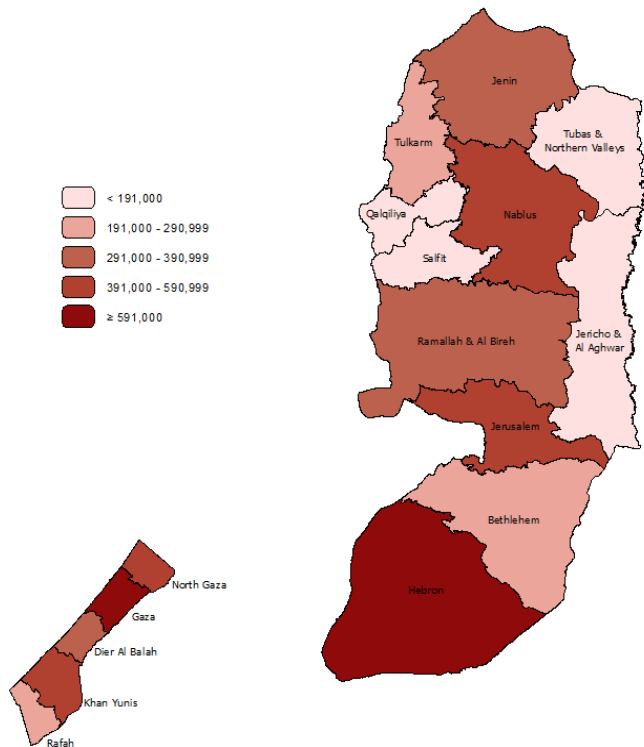

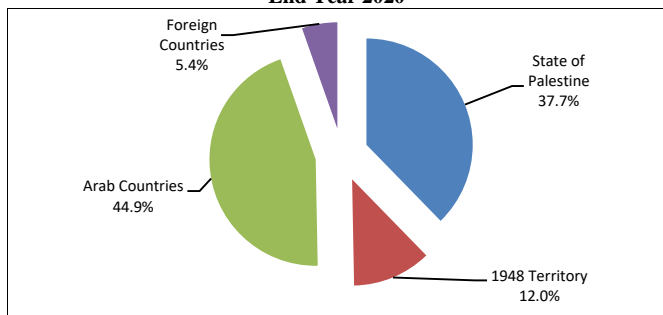
Estimated Population in Palestine by Governorate, (Mid-Year 2020)

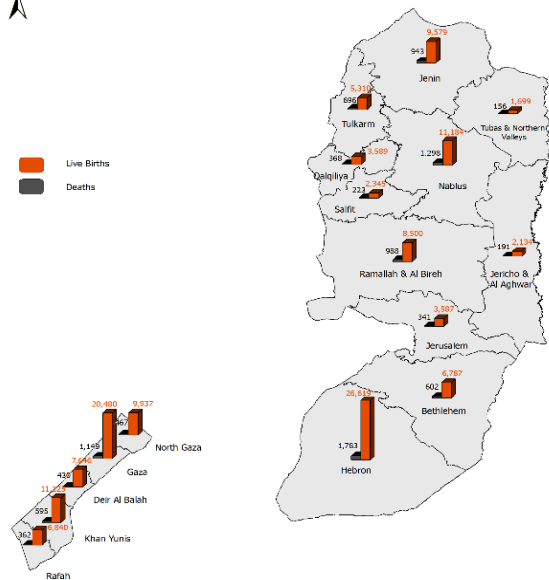

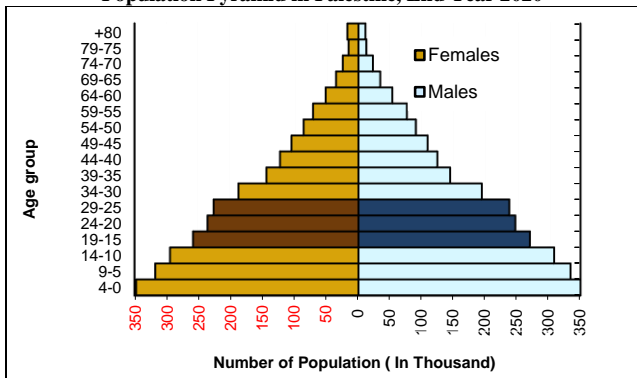

### Registered Live Births and Deaths in Palestine\* by Governorate ,2019

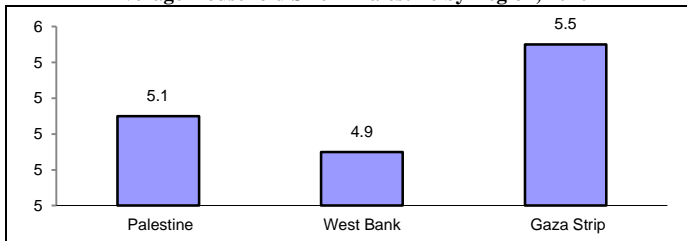

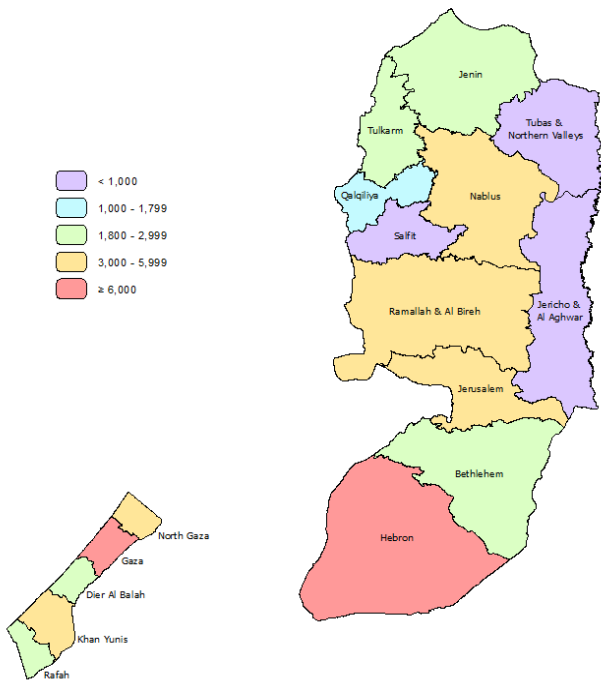

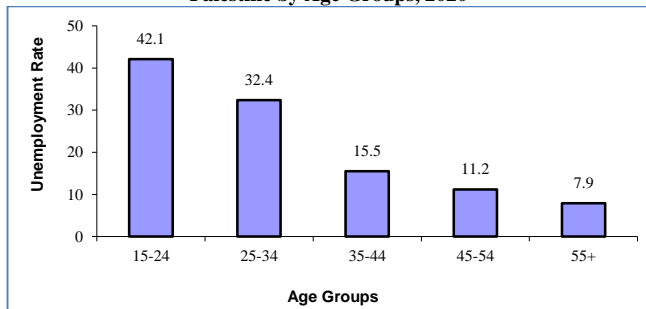

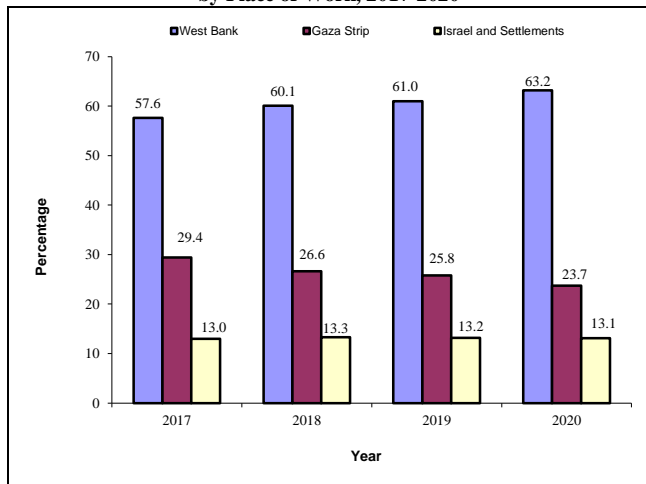
### Unemployment Rate of Participants in Labour Force (15 Years and over) in Palestine by Age Groups, 2020

## Percentage Distribution of Employed Persons (15 Years and over) in Palestine by Place of Work, 2017-2020



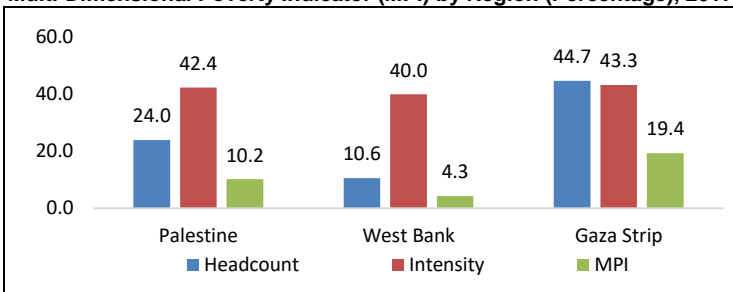

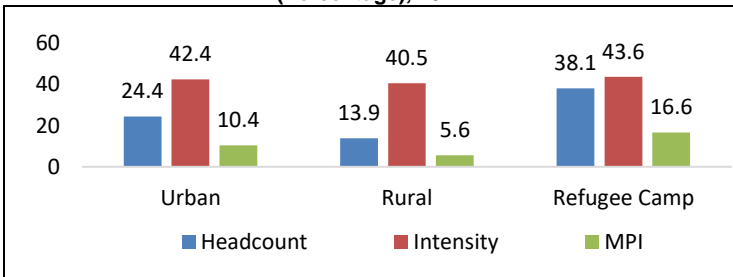

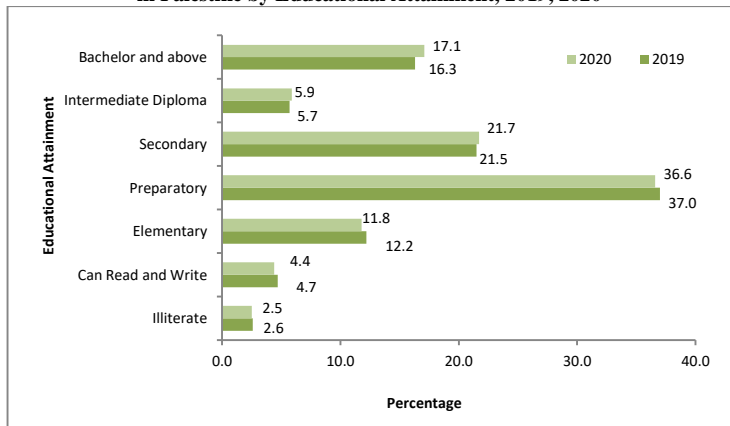

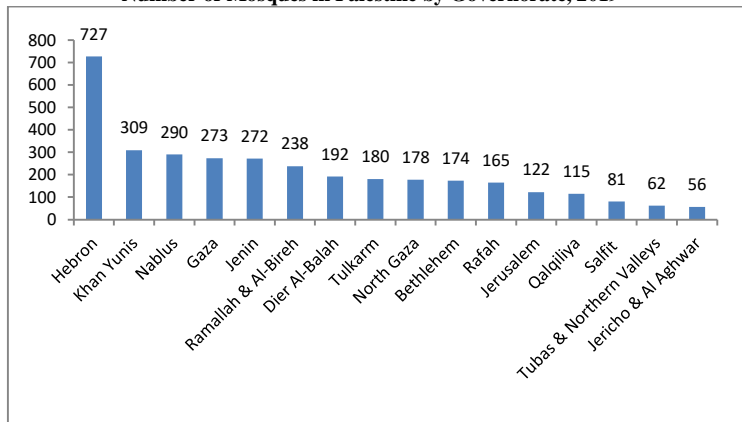

**Number of Mosques in Palestine by Governorate, 2019**

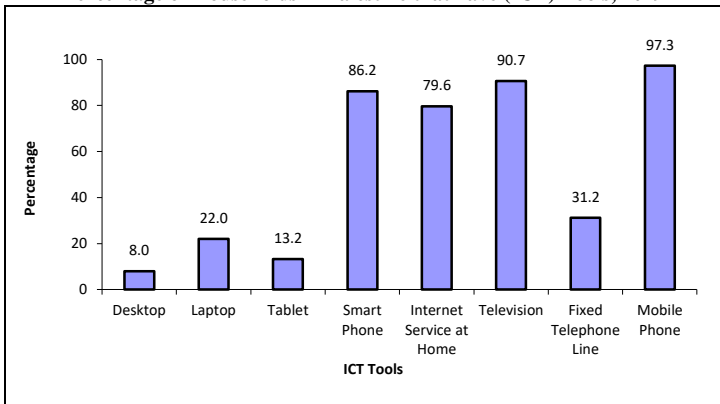

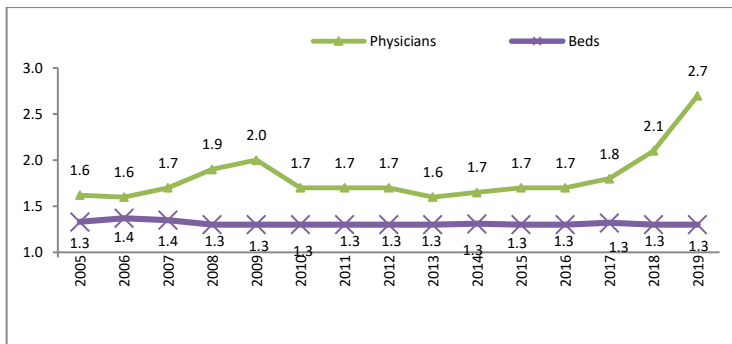

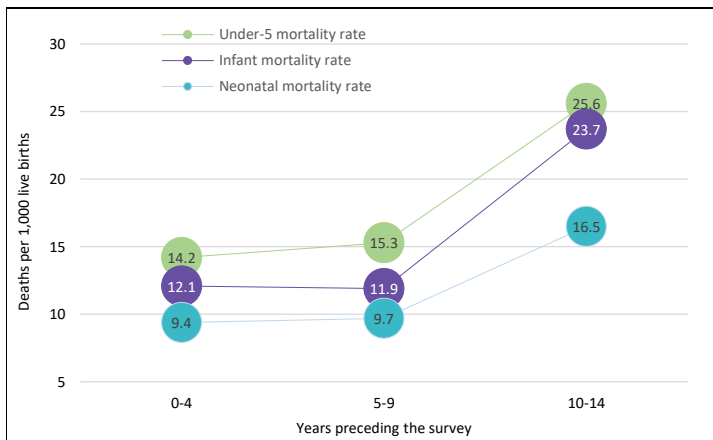

## Mortality Rates among Children Under-5 in Palestine, 2019-2020

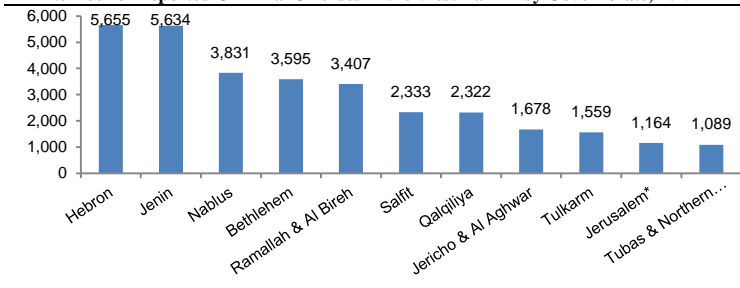

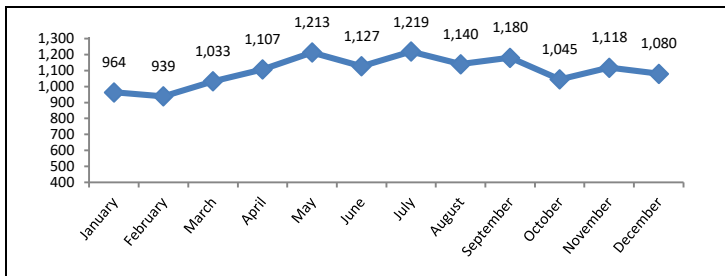

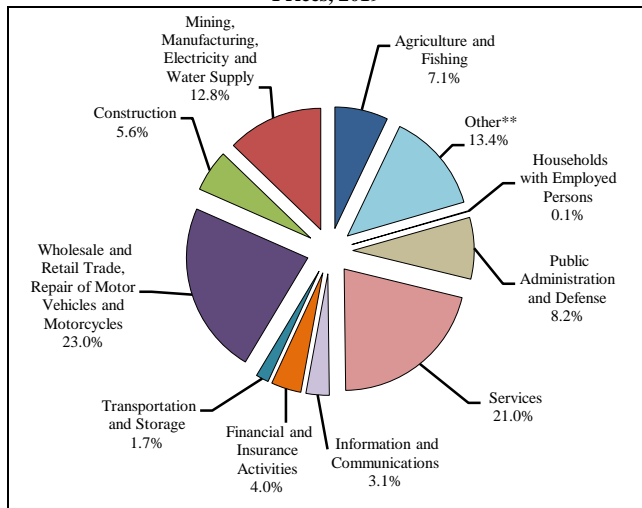

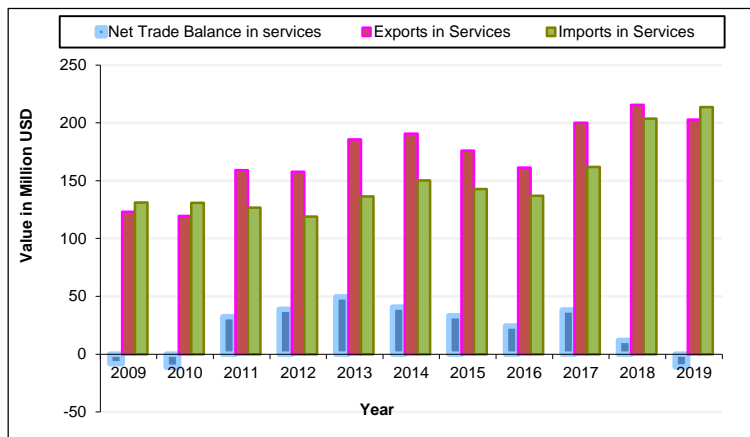

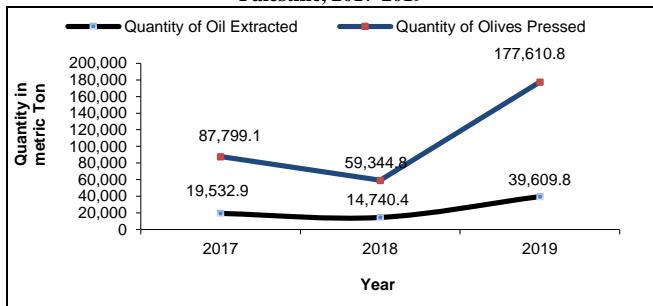

### Quantity of Olives Pressed and Olive Oil Extracted in Palestine, 2017-2019

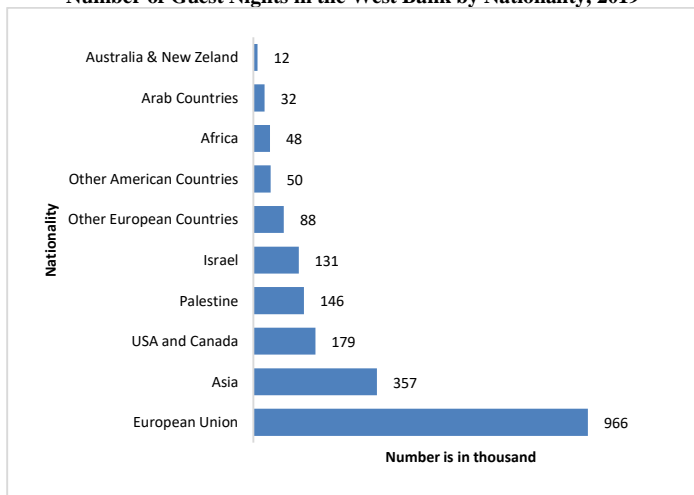

### Number of Guest Nights in the West Bank by Nationality, 2019



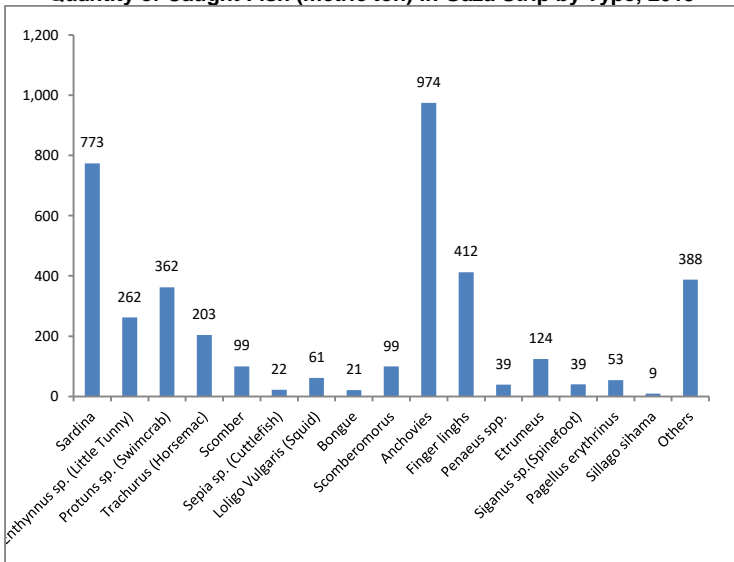

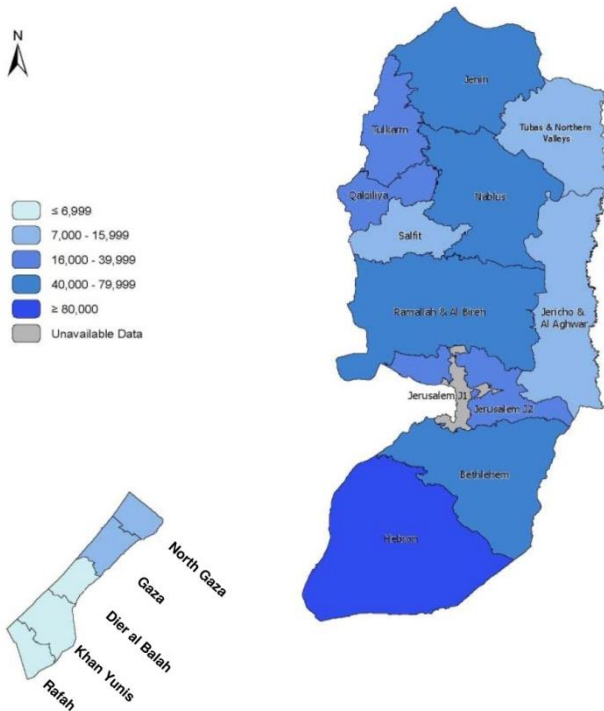

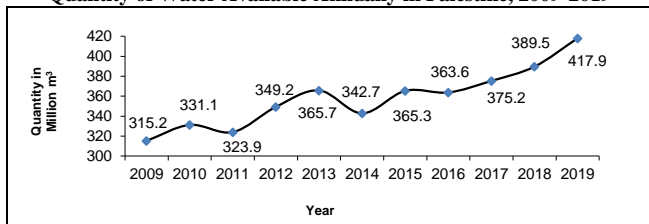

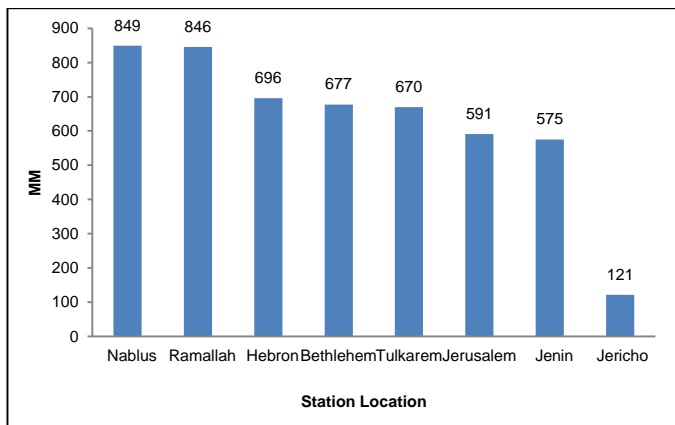

### Quantity of Water Available Annually in Palestine, 2009-2019

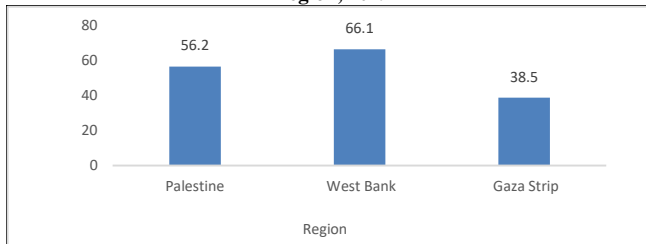

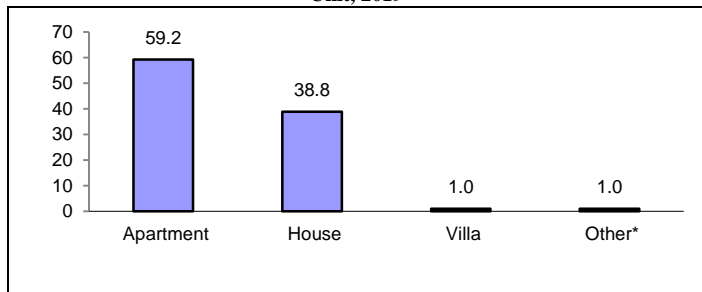

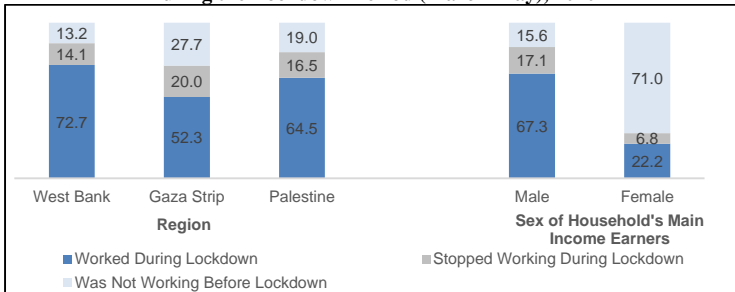

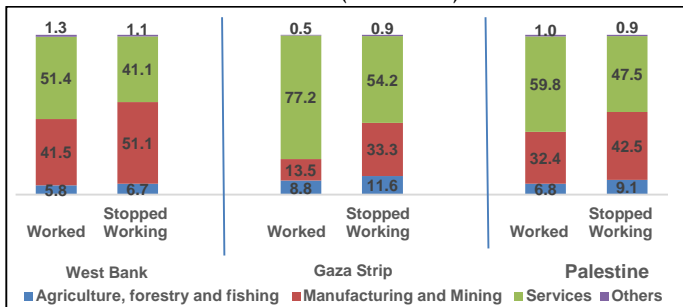

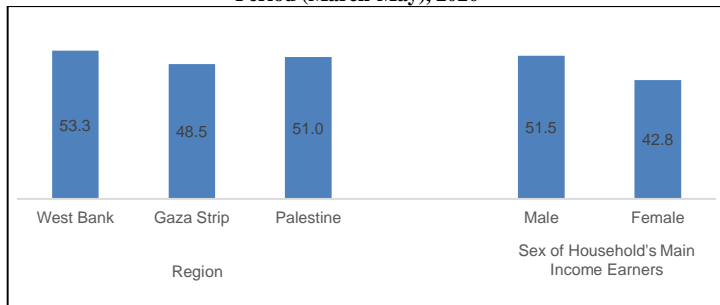

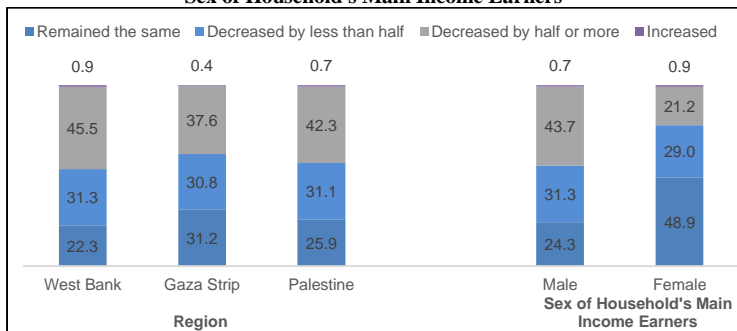

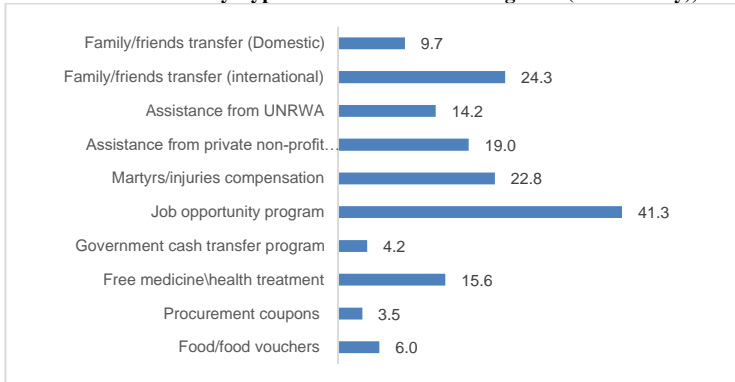

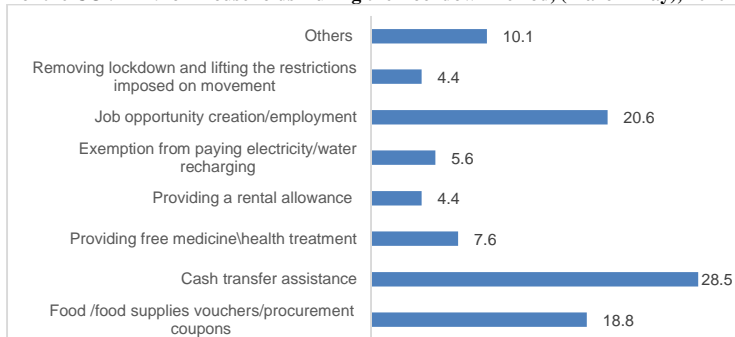

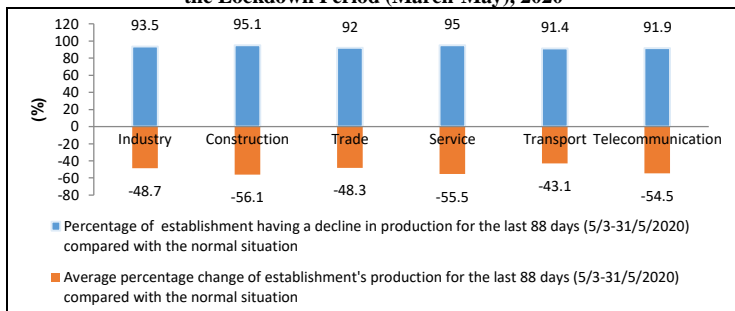
